Closing down at night:

- Turn bathroom heater to ~50
- Make sure fire pit is completely off
- Make sure sliding door is locked, and lock main door on exit (see locking instructions below)
- Set clubhouse heater to ~60
- Turn off all lights
- Pick up balls from court
- Clean up clubhouse area
- Empty garbage can if full

Included in 'league membership':

- Winter league (not summer)
- Free court time all year long
- Free paddle balls
 - These are ~\$5 per ball. Use 1 per match, don't lose them.
- Cost: \$865.10/year, paid annually

Garage Door Lock:

- Unlocking: code is XXXX
- Locking: Shut door fully, click lock symbol, wait, confirm it closed

- Head to Yahoo Mail (*All steps are on the League Page on the site*)
- *Username:* thecedarclub
- *Password:* Paddle6060
- Click "Calendar Full View" on right side
- Insert your time, make sure you're not conflicting with any other time

Open Paddle: Saturday's during the winter season from 10am-1pm. Stop by whenever

Rankings: Live rankings can be found at the club laptop

Ranking Points System:

- 100 points to win the match
- 8 point game bonus
- 6 point strength bonus
- *Example:* Team 1 combined rank of 10 beats Team 2 combined rank of 12. Score is 6-4, 6-0. Team 1 earns 152 points ($100 + 8*8 - 6*2$) while Team 2 loses 152 points.

Hosting Events: If you want to host an event, reach out to Brad Brogan at brad.brogan@gmail.com- typical cost is \$100/event - make sure to check schedule on Yahoo to make sure there's no conflicts

Winter League Scheduling: Brad Schmeeding schedules out typically a month in advance. If you have any conflicts make sure to email him early and he'll do his best to accommodate. His email is schmeeds@hotmail.com.

Winter League Subs:

- Start with a small list as far in advance as possible
 - Look for similar rankings or good match fit
 - Inform playing partners that you are subbing out

Reporting Scores:

- Enter the ranking number so the name populates
- Enter scores
- Save sheet when done

Heaters:

- Switches located in the garage near the electrical panel, they are on timers.
- Do not use heaters during heavy rain. They are meant to dry courts after a rain.
- Do not use heaters when there is standing snow on the court. Courts must be shoveled to allow airflow between court boards before the heaters are turned on.
- You can run them while it is snowing to prevent snow from building up and courts from getting slick.

Lights: Light switches are near heaters switch. Make sure to turn off when play is done for the evening

Beer: Free for everyone, make sure to clean up after you're done. Email dale when kegs are empty: dborowiak@att.net

Shoveling snow off the court:

- Be gentle with the court

- Don't use metal shovel
- Lift up wood panels to push snow under screens
- Shovel walk ways as well
- Don't put salt on court or patio

Clubhouse Speaker

- Connects to main TV and can be connected to via Bluetooth by holding Bluetooth button until flashing.
- Indicator Lights for audio source
 - Orange – TV (HDMI Input)
 - Blue – Bluetooth
 - Red – Optical, do not use.
- You can also adjust speaker volume via remote or buttons on speakers.
 - Keep remote on bar or on speaker

Club Laptop: Do not use club laptop for anything personal, this is for your own security.
