Facilities Information

Closing Down at Night

- *Ensure fire pit is completely off*
- Cover the couch
- Lock sliding door and main door on exit
- Set clubhouse heater to ~60°F
- Set bathroom heater to ~50°F and close window
- Turn off all lights
- Pick up balls from court
- Clean up clubhouse area, throw away empties and cups
- Empty garbage can if full

Garage Door Lock Instructions

- (3PQBs)
- Unlocking: Press any button to wake keypad, enter code, press unlock
- Locking: Shut door fully, click lock symbol, wait, confirm closure **Cou**

rt Booking

- All court reservations must be booked via Reserve My Court (RMC)
- Info sheet available on fridge or google "Reserve my Court", search for Cedar Club, and request access
- Courts are open for play from 8am to 10pm
- If you book a court and it's busy when you get there, kick 'em off.

Permanent Court Reservations

- Women: Mondays, 5–10 PM
- Men: Tuesdays–Thursdays, 6–10 PM
- Men's Open Paddle: Saturdays, 10 AM–1 PM

- All other times: Open for booking

Court Heaters

- Switches are near garage electrical panel, northwest corner.
- Use timers – drying the court usually only takes ~15 min.
- **Only use to dry courts**
- **Do not use during heavy rain or with standing snow**
- **You MUST shovel any standing snow before using heaters**
- Can run during snowfall to prevent buildup

Lights

- Switches near heater controls
- Turn off after play. 10pm is lights out, don't push it too far past that.

Clubhouse Speaker

- Connects to main TV or Bluetooth
- Hold Bluetooth button until flashing to pair
- Indicator Lights:
 - - Orange: TV (HDMI)
 - - Blue: Bluetooth (hold input switch when in BT mode to pair)
 - - Red: Optical (do not use)
- Volume control via Klipsch remote, TV remote, or speaker buttons.
- Keep remote on bar or speaker

Club Laptop

- For club use only
- Do not use for personal activities

- Winter league participation
- Free court time year-round
- Free paddle balls (~\$5 each; use 1 per match)

- Beer and pizza
- Cost: \$1350/year (paid annually)

League Matches

- Show up on time, we've got a schedule here folks!
- If you are going to go WAY over your time, start the third set at 3-3 or something, do not go more than 20 min over your allotted time. No official rules here, make a judgement call or face the wrath of the upcoming match players.
- The highest ranked player plays with the lowest ranked player, use CURRENT rankings

League Match Substitutions

- This is your most important member responsibility
- Check schedule ASAP when released
- On the last page of the live schedule is a member list sorted by rank.
 - Use rankings tab to find subs (± 5 ladder spots). Copy and paste email addresses
 - Expand your search beyond this as necessary.
 - Alternatively, see if a player near your rank is on bye week, start with them.
 - You can also look for good substitutes playing before or after you.
- Email playing partners once sub is confirmed

Reporting Scores

- Enter ranking number to auto-fill name
- Enter scores accurately. Don't lie.

No-Show Policy

- 1st Offense: Additional bye week next month (someone please report no shows to Schmeeds)
- 2nd Offense: Two additional bye weeks the following month
- 3rd Offense: One-month suspension

- 4th Offense: Removal from league
